The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Personal identifiers, contacts and characteristics (for example, name and contact details) that you have provided in person, via email or other means.

How we get the personal information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- Making an enquiry
- Purchasing event tickets
- Other matters relating to you or your organisation on matters relating to our project
- Joining our mailing list which is managed by MailChimp, a third-party platform – see their privacy policy here:

We use the information that you have given us in order to:

- Contact you about your enquiry or purchase
- Contact you in relation to your contract or

We may share this information with administrators at St. John with St. Mary Devizes, Trustees of St. John with St. Mary.

Note that our IT and web administrators may have access to records in our systems and on our mailing software [MailChimp – a third party platform].

Data Protection

At St. Mary Devizes we are committed to complying with the General Data Protection Regulations (implemented from 25th May 2018) to comply with current legal standards and to maintain the trust and confidence of our visitors to our web site, and subscribers to our newsletter. Here you'll find information on how we treat data that we collect from visitors to our website, or when someone subscribes to our newsletter.

How do we collect information from you?

We can collect personal data from you when you visit our website via Contact forms which you may submit or if you register to receive an email newsletter from us. Server logs and Cookies will also collect your (anonymised) IP address.

What type of information is collected from you?

The personal information we collect might include your name, address, email address, IP address, and information regarding what pages are accessed and when you accessed them.

How is your information used?

We may use your personal data such as name, email address and phone number to contact you about queries you have or services you have requested.

We may use the IP address of the device you accessed our website from to gain insights on website visitor behaviour, for instance, which are the most popular pages and how long was spent browsing them. This type of data is anonymised.

We can also use IP address information to identify malicious attacks on the web server.

Who has access to your information?

We will not sell or rent your information to third-parties and we will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes. We will not contact you for marketing purposes electronically or by post if you have indicated that you do not wish to be contacted.

Our staff have access to, and associated IT agency and web support staff may on occasional have access to, software such as our Forms Management system, website database and email system and may have access to data that you have

provided via forms online. Confidential information is not stored on our web server.

We may choose to use a third-party forms management software such as Cognitofoms which is fully GDPR compliant – [see their privacy policy here](#).

Your choices & Access to your Personal Data

You are entitled to know what personal data that we hold and have the right to ask us to amend or delete this information at any time.

Data Security

stmarydevizestrust.org.uk website has an SSL security certificate – the standard security technology for establishing a secure link between a web server and a browser. This link ensures that all data passed between the web server and browsers remain secure and private.

The website is hosted with a third-party, GDPR compliant provider on an EU based server.

Use of Cookies

Like many other websites, the stmarydevizestrust.org.uk website uses small files called Cookies. Cookies are sent to your computer and stored on your hard drive to allow a website to recognise that you have previously visited it when you visit next.

What is a cookie?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your personal computer, mobile or other device when you visit a website. Information is then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit.

Cookies do several jobs, such as making navigating between pages efficient, remembering your preferences and help to improve your experience of a website.

If you click to accept cookies when you visit our website, you allow us to place them on your computer.

Your Browser (Edge, Firefox, Google Chrome, Safari, Opera and mobile web browsers etc.) allow you to control and remove Cookies that have been stored, usually via the **Settings** option. Sometimes this is in the same place where you

Types of Cookie:

Strictly necessary cookies

We may use some functionality-based cookies to help the site work properly. Declining these cookies might change the way the website looks and/or behaves. These cookies are NOT used for targeted advertising.

Performance cookies

These cookies collect anonymous information about users to assess the performance of a website. Common uses include well-known web analytics tools such as 'Google Analytics'. We may use analytics cookies to collect data on how many people visit the website and how they navigate through it. The information collected is no personal and we cannot identify you as an individual this way.

Functionality cookies

These cookies remember choices that users have made in previous visits to the website in order to improve their experience on subsequent visits. For example, where users select their preferred settings and layout.

Third party cookies

We cannot access cookies placed on your devices by third-party sites such as Facebook, Twitter or Google, nor can the third parties access the data in cookies used by our site.

For example, if you choose to 'share' content through Twitter or other social networks you might be sent cookies from these websites. We don't control the setting of these cookies, so you need to check those websites for their cookie information.
